DES WILSON was born in New Zealand in 1941 and grew up in Oamaru where he went to school. At the age of 19 he came to the UK. As a young man he had three enthusiasms: cricket, theatre, and journalism. (These enthusiasms were reflected in later years as a member of the English Cricket Board, an executive with the Royal Shakespeare Company, and a columnist for two leading Fleet Street newspapers, The Guardian and The Observer.) By 25 he was the founding director of Shelter the charity for homeless children.

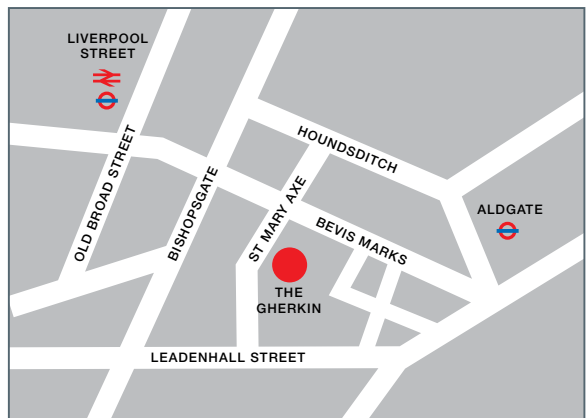

He became President to the Liberal Party in 1986/87 and played a key role in establishing the Liberal Democratic party.
